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### **Directions**

#### **From Airport via Route 41:**

Exit Airport to University Parkway and turn right. Travel South on 41 (Tamiami Trail) and turn right on Clark Road. Head East and turn right at Beneva Road. At Palmer Ranch Parkway turn left. At the TPC Prestancia entrance turn right. The guard gate will direct you to the Clubhouse.

#### **From Interstate 75:**

Exit at #205 (old #37) which is Clark Road and head west. At McIntosh Road turn left. Follow McIntosh until you reach Palmer Ranch Parkway and turn right. The entrance to TPC Prestancia will be on your left. The guard gate will direct you to the Clubhouse.

### **Course Information**

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## EVENT FORMAT

### **Scramble**

This format is probably the most enjoyable type of tournament because only the best shots are played and the pace of the game is very fast. All players drive, the best ball is selected and all players take their next shots from that point. The process is repeated until the ball is “holed out.” The team records one score. Gross scores can be used and handicaps are not required. The scramble format promotes easier and faster scoring.

### **Best Ball**

This format may be played as 2, 3 or 4 person teams. Golfers play their own ball on each hole, and the lowest score is then recorded to be the team score. This format may be played with or without a golf handicap. This is usually a fun format with a medium pace of play. Results can be calculated quickly.

### **Skins**

An individual play format: a “skin” is a point given to the player with the lowest score on an individual hole.

### **Schamble**

This format combines the scramble and best ball formats and can be played in 2, 3 or 4 person teams. All players drive, the best ball is selected and all players take their next shots from that point. Each player then plays their own ball for the rest of the hole and the lowest score is recorded to be the team score.

### **Longest Drive**

Prize awarded for the longest drive from the tee-box (in the fairway); normally played on the course’s longest par 5.

### **Closest to the Pin**

Prize awarded for the shot that comes to rest closest to the pin – played on a par 3.

### **Longest Putt**

Prize awarded to the person who makes the longest putt on a specific green. This is typically played on a low handicap par 4.

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## POLICIES & PROCEDURES

### **Reservation and Cancellation Policy**

All events must be guaranteed by a signed contract and deposit. Failure to return the contract or submit the deposit by the specified date may result in removal of the outing from the starting sheet. The remaining balance is due on the day of the event. A minimum of 90 players is needed to reserve the golf course; any reduction of participants within 14 days of the outing will forfeit the deposit. The deposit will only be refunded in full if the outing is canceled in writing at least 90 days prior to the event. Any players over and above the guaranteed number will be paid for on the day of the event. If another form of payment is not presented, then all outing charges will be automatically charged to the sponsoring Member's account. Outing prices are subject to change if booked more than 6 months in advance.

### **Inclement Weather Policy**

If fewer than 9 holes are completed due to inclement weather, or the course is deemed unplayable by Club management, an 18-hole rain check will be issued to all outing participants (to be redeemed in the same calendar year). All food and beverage arrangements will proceed as planned. Under no conditions will refunds be given for outing fees.

### **Dress Policy**

Our dress code is designed to maintain the highest standards of golf etiquette. Bathing attire, cutoffs, jeans, jean shorts, short shorts, halter tops, and tank tops will not be permitted while using any golf facilities. Gentlemen are asked to always wear collared golf shirts or golf "mocks".

### **6-8 Weeks Prior to the Event**

- Staff or volunteer needs
- Order banners and/or hole sponsorship signs
- Order hole-in-one insurance, if needed
- Update Club with estimated number of players

### **4 Weeks Prior to the Event**

- Choose your menu and finalize the food and beverage contract.

### **2 Weeks Prior to the Event**

Your Tournament Coordinator will request details on the following:

- Final player count
- Format of your competition
- Course contests
- Hole-in-one insurance and prize information
- Special needs for sponsors, volunteers, etc.
- Number of tables needed for registration
- Accurate title and spelling of the event name
- Gift certificate needs
- Other set up information, such as putting contests, placement of tee prizes, placement of sponsor signs, etc.
- Reconfirm the start time and format and player count

### **1 Week Prior to the Event**

- Final Credit Card or Company Check payment due 7 days prior to event: American Express, Visa or MasterCard

### **3 Days Prior to the Event**

### **1 Day Prior to the Event**

- Send a player list if there are any changes
- Deliver Signs and Banners

### **Day of the Event**

- Deliver any signs, banners, prizes or hole-in-one cars that need to be pre-staged the evening prior for an A.M. event and at least 2 hours prior for a P.M. event
- Allow one half hour prior to your scheduled start for registration for every 40 players (for example, 2 hours for 140 players, 1 hour for 80 players)
- Communicate any last minute player changes
- Final payment for the use of the course is due

### **After the Event**

- Remember to pick up any left over prizes
- Remember to pick up any banners or sign
